

RIMCO LLC **PRIVACY POLICY**

This Privacy Policy ("Policy" or "Notice") describes the types of information RIMCO LLC ("RIMCO") may collect from you or that you may provide to us when you access and use <https://rimcocat.com/> and/or <https://parts.cat.com/rimco/> (jointly, the "Site"), and our practices for collecting, using, maintaining, protecting, and disclosing that information.

This Policy is aligned with RIMCO's internal practices and does not in any way clash with any other policies adopted and prepared by RIMCO.

The words "we", "us", or "our" are used interchangeably throughout this Policy to refer to RIMCO.

The terms "you" and "user" are used interchangeably throughout this Policy to refer to any individual, whether a registered or non-registered user, that uses and/or visits the Site.

PURPOSE

This Privacy Policy ("Policy" or "Notice") describes the types of information RIMCO LLC ("RIMCO") may collect from you or that you may provide to us when you access and use <https://rimcocat.com/> and/or <https://parts.cat.com/rimco/> (jointly, the "Site"), and our practices for collecting, using, maintaining, protecting, and disclosing that information.

The words "we", "us", or "our" are used interchangeably throughout this Policy to refer to RIMCO.

The terms "you" and "user" are used interchangeably throughout this Policy to refer to any individual, whether a registered or non-registered user, that uses and/or visits the Site.

EFFECTIVE DATE AND CHANGES TO BE NOTIFIED

This Policy is in effect as of September 01, 2023. We may, from time to time, make changes to this Policy. If this Policy were to be modified either partially or in its entirety, all users of the Site will be able to access the new Policy upon accessing the Site. By visiting the Site, you are accepting the practices described in the current version of this Policy. If you do not agree to the terms of this Policy, do not use the Site.

TYPE OF INFORMATION COLLECTED

We collect Personally Identifiable Information (“PII”), defined as any information relating to an identified or identifiable person, through the Site. This includes first and last name(s), mailing address, physical address, email address, credit or debit card numbers and telephone numbers. We also collect information regarding the users’ employers, including the name, address, and telephone numbers of the said companies. We also collect anonymous demographic information, which is not unique to you, such as your ZIP code, age, gender, preferences, and interests. There is also information about your computer hardware and software that is automatically collected by us. This information can include: your IP address, device type, browser type, operating system, geolocation, domain names, access times and referring website addresses.

WHEN DO WE COLLECT THE INFORMATION

We collect PII when you register with the Site, purchase products, submit a question or comment or otherwise provide feedback, respond to surveys, or search on the Site.

As you navigate through and interact with our Site, we may use automatic data collection technologies to collect certain information about your equipment, browsing actions and patterns, including:

- Details of your visits to the Site, including, but not limited to, traffic data, geolocation data, logs and other communication data and the resources that you access and use on the Site.
- Information about your computer and internet connection, including your IP address, operating system, browser type, clickstream patterns, the URL of the most recent website you visited before coming to our Site, the amount of time you spent on our Site and the pages you viewed while on our Site.
- We also may use these technologies to collect information about your online activities over time and across third-party websites or other online services.
- The information we collect automatically is statistical data and may include PII, but we may maintain it or associate it with PII we collect in other ways or receive from third parties. It helps us to improve our services, including, but not limited to, by enabling us to:
 - Estimate our visitor size and usage patterns.

PURPOSE FOR COLLECTING THE INFORMATION AND WHO WE SHARE IT WITH

We collect data from you only when you voluntarily provide it to us or when you interact with us. RIMCO does not sell, rent, or lease its customer lists to third parties. We use data voluntarily submitted by you in order to provide our services; to sell our products; to provide and improve our own web content, including to provide emails, newsletters, and other information; to respond to visitors' interests, needs and preferences; to develop new products and services; to fulfill your requests; to contact you, including regarding changes to our Site, policies, terms or any products or services we offer or provide; to provide customer support or arrange deliveries; to comply with applicable law(s) (for example, to comply with a search warrant, subpoena or court order); and for other purposes disclosed at the time personal data is collected.

We may disclose your information to third parties who perform services on our behalf, including providing or improving the Site, processing customer orders, and improve or market our products and services. We may disclose your personal data to:

- Hosting providers for the secure storage and transmission of your data.
- Database software providers for the management and tracking of your data.
- Technology providers who assist in the development and management of our software or our website.
- Fulfillment and postal vendors for the fulfillment of our products and services.
- Survey and research providers who perform studies on our behalf.
- Advertising partners, including social media providers, for the delivery of targeted advertisements.
- Business partners and Caterpillar, Inc., for processing customer orders and improving or market our products and services. Caterpillar, Inc. may disclose your information to its affiliates and sub processors that may subprocess on Caterpillar's behalf, including data analytics firms, data cleansing consultants, validation and enrichment consultants, marketing or advertising agencies, customer engagement consulting firms, cloud storage providers, and data backup providers. We link to third party solutions that enable third-party companies to collect certain information when you visit this Site. These companies use non-personally identifiable information (e.g., click stream information, browser type, time and date, subject of advertisements clicked or scrolled over, hardware/software information, cookie and session ID) and information that may allow for identifying you (e.g., static IP address) during your visits to this Site and other websites in order to provide advertisements for products likely to be of greater interest to you or advertising-related services, such as ad delivery, reporting, attribution, analytics, and market research. These third parties typically use a cookie, pixel tag, web beacon or other similar tracking technologies to collect this information. We use the information we get from Google Analytics to analyze user behavior, improve Site performance, personalize the user experience, and analyze the effectiveness of our marketing campaigns. Google Analytics collects only the IP address assigned to you on the date you visit this site, rather than your name or other identifying information. Google Analytics anonymizes the IP address before it is stored. We do not receive the non-anonymized IP address. We may combine the Google Analytics data with first and third-party data information which may include PII. Although Google Analytics plants a permanent cookie on your web browser to identify you as a unique user the next time you visit this site, the cookie cannot be used by anyone but Google. We may disclose your personal data to enforce our policies, to comply with our legal obligations or in the interests of security, public interest, or law enforcement. For example, we may share or disclose your PII if the following circumstances were to arise:

- A governmental, law enforcement or national security agency requests the information pursuant to a statutory requirement or court order.
- You consent and allow for your information to be disclosed to a specific third-party, individual or entity.
- An emergency situation were to arise wherein property or life were at risk.

DO NOT TRACK SIGNALS

Most web browsers and some mobile operating systems and mobile applications include a Do-Not-Track (“DNT”) feature or setting you can activate to signal your privacy preference not to have data about your online browsing activities monitored and collected. No uniform technology standard for recognizing and implementing DNT signals has been finalized. As such, we do not currently respond to DNT browser signals or any other mechanism that automatically communicates your choice not to be tracked online. If a standard for online tracking is adopted that we must follow in the future, we will inform you about that practice in a revised version of this Policy.

HYPERLINKING

The Site may contain links to other websites. This Notice applies only to the Site, so if you click on a link to another website, you should read their privacy policy. While we may have official social media pages, curated, and administered by RIMCO, the applicable privacy policy is that of the social media entity. Once the user leaves the Site, RIMCO is no longer responsible for the user’s PII.

SECURITY MEASURES

RIMCO secures your personal information from unauthorized access, use or disclosure. RIMCO secures the PII you provide on computer servers in a controlled, secure environment, protected from unauthorized access, use or disclosure. When personal information (such as a credit card number) is transmitted to other websites, it is protected with encryption.

RIMCO maintains PII for as long as need be to fulfill the purpose for which the information was collected, and assure compliance with any legal, accounting or reporting requirements. However, there may be instances in which, depending on the purpose for which the information was collected, information storage duration may be specified.

In addition to RIMCO employees, Caterpillar Inc, RIMCO subcontractors and business partners (*e.g.*, Puerto Rico Computer W@W) may have access to the user’s personal information to the extent necessary to send out marketing materials that the user has voluntarily signed up for and/or provide the products and services offered in the Site. The number of RIMCO employees, business partners and subcontractors are limited and adheres to confidentiality and security protocols established by RIMCO to safeguard all personal information. These confidentiality and security protocols fall within the scope of federal and Puerto Rico law.

YOUR CHOICES REGARDING YOUR INFORMATION

Also, you may request deletion of certain personal information maintained by us, and we will use commercially reasonable efforts to honor your request, but please note that we may be legally or otherwise required to keep such information and not delete it (or to keep this information for a certain time, in which case we will comply with your deletion request only after we have fulfilled such requirements). Deletion requests may be made by emailing us at digitalsupport@rimcocat.com. When we delete information, it will be deleted from the active database, but may remain in our archives. We may also retain your information to prevent fraud or other unlawful activity or for similar purposes.

APPLICABLE LAWS

The Site complies with applicable federal law and Puerto Rico law. The Site is hosted in the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico and is intended for and directed to users located in the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico and for promoting products, services, and business operations within the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico. If you are a user accessing the Site from outside of Puerto Rico, including the European Union, Asia, or any other region with laws or regulations governing personal data collection, use, and disclosure that differ from United States and Puerto Rico laws, please be advised that through your continued use of the Site, which is governed by applicable federal law and Puerto Rico law, this Notice and our Terms and Conditions you are transferring your personal information outside of the country or jurisdiction where you are located to the United States and you consent to that transfer. The Site is not intended to subject us to the laws or jurisdiction of any state, country, or territory other than those of the United States and the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico. If you do not reside in the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico and you do not want your information transferred to, processed, or maintained outside of the country or jurisdiction where you are located, you should not use the Site.

The Site is not intended to be used by minors under the age of 13.
